## **Security**

MIT Lincoln Laboratory is a secure facility. Help us maintain our security posture by cooperating and following these rules during your visit:

- Conference attendees may freely access
  - Main Lobby
  - Immediate area surrounding the Auditorium
  - Cafeteria entrance, Cafeteria, and concourse
- Access to any area inside the security perimeter of the Laboratory requires a continuous escort by a cleared employee.

## **Conference Badges**

The rules for use of conference badges are as follows:

- 100% ID check is required.
- Badges are the property of MIT Lincoln Laboratory and must be returned at the end of each day.
- · Badges will be reissued each day.

## **Electronic Devices**

- Cameras, video cameras, and other recording devices are not permitted in the Laboratory.
- Bluetooth may not be used at anytime while onsite at Lincoln Laboratory.
- Cell phones and other devices with embedded cameras are restricted in many areas of the Laboratory. Their use is permitted in public areas and adjacent to the Auditorium; however, the imaging function of these devices must not be used.
